INTRODUCTION

The following information is provided to inform you of AMBULANCE TRANSFER FEES.

IN-PROVINCE

For individuals with SASKATCHEWAN Healthcare coverage, there is NO provision for coverage of Ambulance transfers as an Inpatient or as an Outpatient. You are responsible for these Ambulance costs and will be billed directly for these services.

Fees:

Current Road Ambulance Transfer Fee Structure (Fees are subject to change without notice):

Basic Charge:	\$245.00
Paramedic Service:	\$325.00 (Canora & Yorkton)
Mileage:	\$2.30 /km billed roundtrip
Wait Charge:	\$80.00 / hr

APPROXIMATE CHARGES:

Yorkton Hospital to Regina: **\$ 1414.00**

Yorkton Hospital to Saskatoon: **\$2249.00**

*There will be additional charges for waiting times.

- Sask. Air Ambulance and STARS **\$350.00** deductible plus local Ambulance charges at both pick up and destination sites are your responsibility. Depending on the situation there also may be fire department charges as well

(Fees are subject to change without notice)

- If a special attendant is required during the transfer, there will be an additional charge of up to **\$100.00** per hour
- If you are a Saskatchewan senior 65 years or older and are being transported by **road** ambulance, a deductible of **\$275.00** is your responsibility, the government covers the rest. This does not apply to patients with a valid First Nations Treaty Card

If you have other coverage such as (Blue Cross, Social Services, GMS, Veteran Affairs), these charges may be covered.

- Patients being returned to their home health facility for convalescence are the responsibility of their home ambulance service and will be charged in accordance with the home service rates.

When a patient is transported by an ambulance, they will remain responsible for all fees including when:

- referred to a specialist
- services are not provided by the Sunrise Health Region ie: MRI
- services are interrupted
- an alternate mode of transportation could have been used
- being transferred to a higher or a lower level of care within the Province of Saskatchewan.

OUT-OF-PROVINCE

Out of province patients will be responsible for full ambulance costs incurred and will need to access their provincial benefit plan for reimbursement. Out of Province fees are as follows: **\$360.00** for basic pick up
\$3.05 per km. mileage
\$100.00 / hr waiting time
