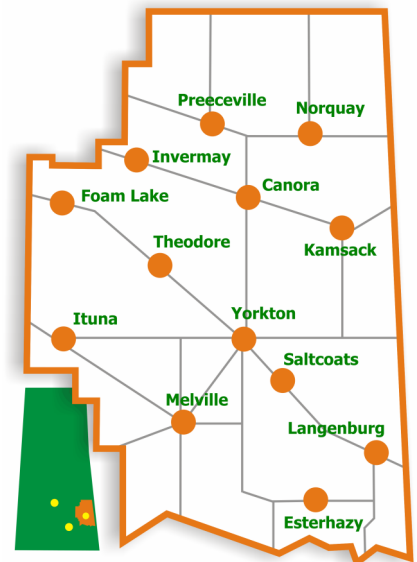

- All complete applications must be received by the Employment Coordination department prior to completion of the student's final semester courses and/or practicum placement.
- **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
- Sunrise Health Region considers each applicant based on organizational/facility needs, available funding, and enrollment/completion dates.
- Funds will only be approved and released to the student upon acceptance of a formal offer of
- employment from a Sunrise Health Region facility.
- Bursary amount will be determined based on the position offered to, and accepted by the student.

4) Conditions of Employment:

- A criminal record check/vulnerable sector check is required prior to receipt of an offer of employment.
- All employment offers are conditional upon the successful completion of a Probationary Period as identified by the respective Union and Collective Bargaining Agreement.
- All employees are required to join and pay for Benefit Plans appropriate to their position and status.
- All deductions required by law will be automatically deducted from each pay statement.
