Turning Point Program

Ensures individuals and families who are infected or affected by HIV or Hepatitis C are better able to achieve positive health and social outcomes.

Goals:

- Improve access to health care and social services.
- Prevention of HIV, Hepatitis C, and Sexually Transmitted infections .
- Increase individuals knowledge and understanding of HIV, Hepatitis C, and Sexually Transmitted infections.
- Support for positive health changes.
- Access to risk reduction services, including safer injection supplies and safer sex supplies.
- Assistance with housing and social supports.

HIV Support

Anyone living with HIV and requiring additional support can be referred to HIV Supportive Program.

Our goal is to improve an individual's and families quality of life who are infected or affected by HIV by promoting and supporting independence.

We can offer assistance with:

- Accessing health care services.
- Housing and food security issues.
- Transportation to Infectious Disease Clinic appointments .
- Navigating the legal/justice system.
- Social supports.
- Personal knowledge and understanding of HIV, Hepatitis C and Sexually Transmitted Infections.
- Accessing services for safer injection supplies and safer sex supplies.
- Immunizations.
- Liaison between Physicians and other health care providers.

Turning Point Program is client-centered, harm reduction and strength based program that meets individuals where they are at.
